Title/subject: **Calibration/verification interval**

Reference document: OD CIG 023
Document issued date: November 2020

Clause: 6.1

Question: The extension of the calibration interval to more than one year shall be limited to seldomly used test equipment only (e.g. mechanical equipment).
It shall not be used for testing equipment used for routine tests.

Decision:

- ➔ Equipment to perform routine testing and periodic tests (PVT's) shall be calibrated/verified with an interval of maximum 12 month.
- ➔ In any case, the equipment to perform routine testing shall have a valid calibration/verification status at the time when the production of certified products runs.
- ➔ The reference equipment shall have a calibration traceable to (inter)national standards and documented by a calibration certificate.
- ➔ The extension of the calibration interval to more than one year shall be limited to seldomly used test equipment (other than used for routine/periodic tests; e.g. mechanical equipment).
